

Covid Information

The impact of COVID-19 requires that WRCLC modify and change many of our policies temporarily. As we monitor updates from the CDC, Virginia Department of Health, and the Virginia Department of Social Services, the safety of the children and staff is paramount. The duration of these temporary changes will depend on how COVID-19 continues to impact our world.

Current policy changes:

- Children 5 years old and up must wear a mask when entering our building.
- The person dropping off and picking up must also wear a mask when entering the building.
- Upon arrival children will have their temperature taken as soon as they enter the building.
- When children are picked up their temperature will be taken again as they leave the building.
- Children will wash their hands as soon as they get to their classrooms upon arriving in the morning. They are also required to wash their hands before they eat, after they eat, when they return from playing outside, after using the restroom, before and after making crafts and using craft supplies, before and after playing games, and before they leave for the day.
- Parents are not allowed to go beyond the front office at this time. We are trying to limit the number of people and germs in our facility as much as possible.
- We are currently not letting visitors into the classrooms. If there is a problem that needs to be addressed, let the Director know so an appointment time can be scheduled to discuss the matter.

OSP Parents--these changes are also applicable to your children participating in our virtual learning classrooms:

- Children need to bring a refillable water bottle every day. All our water fountains are for filling up water bottles only, they are not for drinking.
- Children must bring a morning snack, lunch and afternoon snack in a lunch box with icepacks if needed to keep food fresh. They are not to give food to others or trade food, no exceptions.
- Electronics—Children that are in our OSP program are required to bring their Chromebook, headphones and charger daily. They are not allowed to bring any other electronic device. This includes cell phones, iPods, tablets, etc.
