At Warwick River Christian, we offer a developmentally age-appropriate, hands-on curriculum that encourages students to be critical thinkers and problem solvers.

We educate the whole child, finding ways to involve the left and right sides of the brain.

We teach the word of God each school day and weave a Biblical perspective into each subject. Various strategies are used to create the Christian foundation our students need to grow and flourish in today's world. At the core of our high-quality Kindergarten-1st grade program is a nurturing environment that promotes the physical, social, emotional, intellectual, and spiritual development of each student.

Our students develop a wide range of skills, including physical, social, emotional, language and literacy, and thinking (cognitive) skills.

Physical development includes emphasizing gross motor skills and fine motor skills. Skipping across the grass, running to line up and playing ball are all using large motor skills. Manipulating playdough, cutting with scissors, or building with building toys utilize small motor skills with their hands. Playing outside and taking physical activity breaks during the day help children build healthy bones and muscles, focus better, and feel less stress.

Social and Emotional development helps your child get along with others and better understand themselves as social beings. At Warwick River Christian, we use a biblical lens to support children's social skills by helping them work together, make friends, and resolve disagreements. We help students understand their feelings and the feelings of others. We also support children's development of self-regulation—being able to manage their feelings and behavior.

Literacy and thinking skills are promoted through each subject in the curriculum at Warwick River Christian. For more on each subject read below. Speaking and listening (oral language)- Oral language skills allow children to communicate effectively and are strongly linked to reading and writing. To support these skills, teachers explore new vocabulary words with children during science, math, social studies, and art, while on field trips, and during reading and computer time. Students are also given opportunities to talk about what they know and make connections to their own lives.

Reading -Children enter with different reading experiences and skills. Students will continue to develop reading skills and a love of reading. Students work to develop confidence with letter recognition and beginning letter sounds. They will have the opportunity to read every day, individually or in a group. They also learn parts of written language, such as numbers and punctuation.

Writing-Your child will work on many skills to develop his writing. This includes strengthening the fine motor muscles in his hands. Students are taught to form letters correctly, draw pictures to plan stories, memorize high-frequency words, and begin to spell by sounding out.

Math-Numbers are all around us! At Warwick River Christian, we use math concepts during everyday activities and encourage children to solve real problems. Students explore number sense, addition, subtraction, and the concept of equality. Students also investigate measurement, money, and time. Concepts are reinforced with games and hands-on-activities.

Science-In the beginning, God created! Students will make discoveries in relation to how God designed our world. Concepts include building and taking apart things, examining objects, thinking about why certain things happen, and explaining what they find out. We help children think like scientists—to predict what will happen, test their ideas, come up with solutions.

Bible- The spiritual development of our students includes Bible stories, prayer, weekly Bible verses to memorize and weekly chapel. Christian attitudes of truth, peace, integrity, and love toward one another are emphasized. At Warwick River Christian, we approach all subjects through a biblical lens.

Our Kindergarten-First Grade programs carefully attends to the spiritual and emotional development of each child. Bible stories, memory verses, and scripture songs are among our daily activities. A consistent, firm, and loving classroom environment, as well as affirmation of self-esteem and acceptance, are provided for each child's emotional development.

Enrichment activities extending the curriculum include science experiments, computer programs, art, music, foreign language, physical education, and other hands-on readiness skills. Story/quiet time will also be incorporated into the program.

Morning Drop Off

Carline is from 8:30 to 8:45 each morning. Students arriving later will need to come in through the main office. Children that attend our before school care program will be walked to the classroom at 8:30. Afternoon Pick-Up Carline is from 3:10 to 3:25. Children not picked up by 3:25 will be walked to the Learning Center. Only people listed on the registration will be allowed to pick up children. Staff members will request identification if the person picking up a child is unknown to the staff member. If you need to pick your child up early, please go to the main office.

Monthly Payments

Monthly payments are due on the first of each month August - May. An invoice will be emailed approximately 10 days before the start of each month. A \$35 dollar late fee will apply after the 15th of each month.

Semester Payments

Semester payments are due on the 1st of August and the 1st of January. An invoice will be emailed approximately 10 days before the start of each month. The 3% discount will be lost and \$35 late fee will apply after the 15th of September and February.

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Kindergarten Through First Grade 2026-2027 TUITION

Registration Fee: \$350/student

Must be 5 years old by September 30 to enroll in our Kindergarten class. All classes start at 8:30 and dismissal is at 3:10. Early dismissal days will be at 12:30.

Families of Students: To guarantee your child's place in any of our programs for the 2026-2027 school year, the Registration Form, Registration Fee and a completed, signed Enrollment Agreement must be returned.
